#### III. APPOINTMENTS:

#### A. SENIOR CITIZENS ADVISORY COUNCIL

(1) Individual to serve as 3<sup>rd</sup> District Representative 1 on the Council.

Crystal Miles, Villa Park City Council, and Dan Kalmick, Huntington Beach were nominated from the floor. The 3<sup>rd</sup> District Cities voted by roll call. After one ballot, Crystal Miles received a majority of votes (3). This appointment is for a two-year term beginning January 1, 2021 and expires December 31, 2022\*.

\*Please note this term is being adjusted to stagger the two 3<sup>rd</sup> District position terms.

(1) Individual to serve as 4<sup>th</sup> District Representative 2 on the Council.

Amelia Castro, Anaheim, was nominated from the floor. The 4<sup>th</sup> District Cities voted by roll call and appointed Amelia Castro as the 4<sup>th</sup> District Representative 2. This appointment is for a term expiring December 31, 2021\*.

\*Please note this term is being adjusted to stagger the two 4<sup>th</sup> District position terms

## **B. ORANGE COUNTY TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY (OCTA)**

(1) Mayor/Council Member to serve as the 2nd Supervisorial District Board Member on the Orange County Transportation Authority's Board of Directors, to be appointed on a One City/One Vote basis.

Marshall Goodman, La Palma City Council, and Patrick Harper, Fountain Valley City Council submitted their candidate statements. Marshall Goodman withdrew his candidacy. The 2<sup>nd</sup> District cities voted by roll call and appointed Patrick Harper as the 2<sup>nd</sup> Supervisorial District Board Member. This appointment is for a two-year term beginning January 1, 2021 and expires December 31, 2022.

#### C. ORANGE COUNTY LOCAL AGENCY FORMATION COMMISSION

## (1) Mayor/Council Member to serve as Alternate Orange County City Representative

Peggy Huang, Yorba Linda City Council and Steven Vargas, Brea City Council submitted their candidate statements. The City Selection Committee voted by roll call. After one ballot, Peggy Huang received a majority of votes (22). This appointment is to complete the existing term that began July 1, 2020 and expires June 30, 2024.

#### D. ORANGE COUNTY HOUSING FINANCE TRUST

(1) Mayor/Council Member whose city is a current member of the Trust, is not currently on the Board of Directors representing the Central, North or South Service Planning Areas and whose city population is over 60,000

Kelly Jennings, Laguna Niguel City Council and Fred Jung, Fullerton City Council submitted their candidate statements. Letitia Clark, Tustin City Council withdrew her candidacy. The City Selection Committee voted by roll call. After three ballots, Fred Jung received a majority of votes (7). This appointment is for a two-year term beginning date of appointment.

#### E. EMERGENCY MEDICAL CARE COMMITTEE

(1) Mayor/Council Member to serve as the City Member Representative

Jon Dumitru, Orange City Council submitted his candidate statement. Rebecca Gomez, Tustin City Council was nominated from the floor. The City Selection Committee voted by roll call. After one ballot, Rebecca Gomez received a majority of votes (19). This appointment is to complete a two-year term ending June 30, 2022.
