APPOINTMENTS:

a. SENIOR CITIZENS ADVISORY COUNCIL

• (1) Individual to serve as 3rd District Representative 1 on the Council. To secure this seat, the candidate must obtain votes by the majority of the cities within the Third supervisorial district. Those cities are Irvine, Orange, Tustin, Villa Park and Yorba Linda. This appointment is for a two-year term beginning January 1, 2021 and expires December 31, 2022*. This seat is currently vacant.

• (1) Individual to serve as 4th District Representative 2 on the Council. To secure this seat, the candidate must obtain votes by the majority of the cities within the Fourth Supervisorial District. Those cities are Anaheim, Brea, Buena Park, Fullerton, La Habra and Placentia. This appointment is for a term that expires December 31, 2021*. This seat is currently held by Denise Barnes, Anaheim.

b. ORANGE COUNTY TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY (OCTA)

• (1) Mayor/Council Member to serve as the 2nd Supervisorial District Board Member on the Orange County Transportation Authority's Board of Directors, to be appointed on a One City/One Vote basis. The candidate must obtain votes by the majority of the cities within the Second Supervisorial District. Those cities are Costa Mesa, Cypress, Fountain Valley, Huntington Beach, La Palma, Los Alamitos, Newport Beach, Seal Beach and Stanton. This appointment is for a two-year term that will begin January 1, 2021 and expire December 31, 2022. This seat is currently vacant.

c. LOCAL AGENCY FORMATION COMMISSION (LAFCO)

• (1) Mayor/Council Member to serve as the Alternate Orange County City Representative on the Commission. To secure this seat, the candidate must obtain votes by the majority of the City Selection Committee. This term began July 1, 2020 and expires June 30, 2024. This seat is currently vacant.

d. ORANGE COUNTY HOUSING FINANCE TRUST

• (1) Mayor/Council Member whose city is a current member of the Trust, is not currently on the Board of Directors representing the Central, North or South Service Planning Areas and whose city population is over 60,000, to serve pursuant to the Orange County Housing Finance Trust Joint Powers Agreement and its adopted bylaws. This seat is for a two-year term beginning date of appointment. This seat is currently vacant.
