Barbara Delgleize, Huntington Beach City Council submitted her candidate statement. The 2<sup>nd</sup> District cities voted by roll call and appointed Barbara Delgleize, Huntington Beach City Council. This appointment is for a two-year term that will begin January 1, 2022 and expires December 31, 2023.

(1) Mayor/Council Member to serve as the 3rd Supervisorial District Board Member on the Orange County Transportation Authority's Board of Directors, to be appointed on a One City/One Vote basis.

Gene Hernandez, Yorba Linda City Council submitted his candidate statement. The 3<sup>rd</sup> District cities voted by roll call and appointed Gene Hernandez, Yorba Linda City Council. This appointment is for a two-year term that will begin January 1, 2022 and expires December 31, 2023.

(1) Mayor/Council Member to serve as the 4th Supervisorial District Board Member on the Orange County Transportation Authority's Board of Directors, to be appointed on a population weighted vote basis

Harry Sidhu, Anaheim City Council and Art Brown, Buena Park City Council submitted their candidate statements. The 4<sup>th</sup> District cities voted by roll call and appointed Harry Sidhu, Anaheim City Council. This appointment is for a two-year term that will begin January 1, 2022 and expires December 31, 2023.

The 5<sup>th</sup> District cities voted by roll call and appointed Brian Goodell, Mission Viejo City Council. This appointment is for a two-year term that will begin January 1, 2022 and expires December 31, 2023.
