- **CALL TO ORDER**
- **APPROVAL OF November 13, 2025, REGULAR MEETING MINUTES**

- **APPOINTMENTS:**

- a. **CITY SELECTION CHAIR AND VICE CHAIR**

- **(1) Mayor** to serve as **Committee Chair** to the Orange County City Selection Committee. Any candidate who wishes to secure this seat must be a Mayor of an Orange County City at time of appointment and receive votes by the majority of the City Selection Committee. This appointment is for a term of one year. Term begins May 2026 and expires May 2027. This seat is currently held by David Shawver, Mayor of Stanton.
- **(1) Mayor** to serve as **Committee Vice Chair** to the Orange County City Selection Committee. Any candidate who wishes to secure this seat must be a Mayor of an Orange County City at time of appointment and receive votes by the majority of the City Selection Committee. This appointment is for a term of one year. Term begins May 2026 and expires May 2027. This seat is currently held by Pat Burns, Huntington Beach City Council.

- b. **CITY ENGINEERS FLOOD CONTROL ADVISORY COMMITTEE**

- **(1) City Engineer or City Director of Public Works** to serve as **2<sup>nd</sup> District Member** on the City Engineers Flood Control Advisory Committee. To secure this seat, the candidate must be a City Engineer or City Director of Public Works and a member of The City Engineers Association of Orange County (CEAOC). The candidate must obtain two votes comprising a majority of the cities within the Second supervisorial district. Those cities are Orange, Santa Ana and Tustin. This three-year term begins upon appointment. This seat is currently vacant. CEAOC nominates Kenny Nguyen, Tustin Deputy Director of Public Works/City Engineer.

- c. **ORANGE COUNTY OLDER ADULTS ADVISORY COMMISSION**

- **(1) Individual** to serve as **1<sup>st</sup> District Representative 2** on the Commission. To secure this seat, the candidate must obtain five votes comprising a majority of the cities within the First supervisorial district. Those cities are Cypress, Fountain Valley, Garden Grove, Huntington Beach, La Palma, Los Alamitos, Seal Beach and Westminster. This appointment is for a two-year term that begins January 1, 2026, and expires December 31, 2027. This seat is currently vacant.
- **(1) Individual** to serve as **2<sup>nd</sup> District Representative 1** on the Commission. To secure this seat, the candidate must obtain two votes comprising a majority of the cities within the Second supervisorial district. Those cities are Orange, Santa Ana and Tustin. This appointment is for a two-year term that began January 1, 2025, and expires December 31, 2026. This seat is currently vacant.

- **(1) Individual** to serve as **2<sup>nd</sup> District Representative 2** on the Commission. To secure this seat, the candidate must obtain two votes comprising a majority of the cities within the second supervisorial district. Those cities are Orange, Santa Ana and Tustin. This appointment is for a two-year term that begins January 1, 2026, and expires December 31, 2027. This seat is currently vacant.
- **(1) Individual** to serve as **3<sup>rd</sup> District Representative 2** on the Commission. To secure this seat, the candidate must obtain four votes comprising a majority of the cities within the Third supervisorial district. Those cities are Irvine, Lake Forest, Mission Viejo, Rancho Santa Margarita, Villa Park and Yorba Linda. This appointment is for a two-year term that begins January 1, 2026, and expires December 31, 2027. This seat is currently vacant.

**e. HOUSING & COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION**

- **(1) Individual** to serve as the **City Member 1** on the Commission. To secure this nomination, the candidate must obtain votes by the majority of the City Selection Committee. This appointment nomination is for a two-year term that begins July 1, 2026, and expires June 30, 2028. This seat is currently held by Cecilia Hupp, Brea City Council.
- **(1) Individual** to serve as the **City Member 2** on the Commission. To secure this nomination, the candidate must obtain votes by the majority of the City Selection Committee. This appointment nomination is for a two-year term that begins July 1, 2026, and expires June 30, 2028. This seat is currently held by Mike Frost, Dana Point City Council.

**f. ORANGE COUNTY EMERGENCY MEDICAL CARE COMMITTEE**

- **(1) Mayor/Council Member** to serve as the **City Member Representative** on the Committee. To secure this seat, the candidate must obtain votes from the majority of the City Selection Committee. This appointment is to complete a two-year term that begins July 1, 2026, and expires June 30, 2028. This seat is currently held by Blair Stewart, Brea City Council.

**g. ORANGE COUNTY LOCAL AGENCY FORMATION COMMISSION (LAFCO)**

- **(1) Mayor/Council Member** to serve as the **Orange County City Representative** on the Commission. To secure this seat, the candidate must obtain votes from the majority of the City Selection Committee. This appointment is for a four-year term that begins July 1, 2026, and expires June 30, 2030. This seat is currently held by Peggy Huang, Yorba Linda City Council.
